All students (+1 parent, to sign instrument hire contract) will be required to come along to the Training Band Hand out day on Thursday January 31st at 8am to collect their music bag, music book, folder and instrument if they are hiring. Mentors will be on hand to show your child how to set up and clean the instrument.

Tutor information will be sent as soon as possible. Sorry for the delay. Tutors can be difficult to arrange as they work out their own timetable, have holidays etc. Therefore, please make contact as soon as possible, and ask to commence tutor sessions from Term 1, Week 2.
