
Parent Information Evenings

Could band students please bring their instrument on the day. The group photos will be available for viewing online after the photo day and orders can then be made directly online (no envelope required). Banking is on Friday's! Please ensure that your deposit slip is fully completed with your student number, along with the correct money and no foreign coins please!


As this will be my 6th and last year for co-ordinating the school banking program, I will be asking for anyone that would be interested in taking over this role to contact me.
