Attendance

As we continue through learning from home, just a reminder that a student may be counted as attending school if there is reasonable evidence of participation in learning from home. This is shown through engagement in learning activities provided by the school while students are learning from home by posting learning tasks daily. Teachers do need to see reasonable evidence of this each day. Our stage teams have set their tasks to be 'submitted'. Other tasks are simply assigned to complete i.e. not all tasks need to be submitted each day.

We take account of students whose work is delivered and collected in hard copy and your teachers will be in direct communication with you. With students learning through paper packs this work will be collected weekly and marked as attendance.
